



# Easy Magical DIY Unicorn Bath Bombs

Wanna treat yourself to this super-sweet treat? These easy DIY unicorn bath bombs are the perfect way to unwind and make your bath a little more magical.

## Ingredients

- ♥ 1 cup Baking Soda
- ♥ 1/2 cup Citric Acid
- ♥ 2 tablespoons carrier oil of choice
- ♥ 1 tablespoon Epsom Salt
- ♥ 30-40 drops of EO/FO
- ♥ Blue, Gold, Red & Sparkle White Mica Colors

*This recipe makes about 4 unicorn bath bombs.*

## Directions:

1. Combine the baking soda, citric acid, and Epsom salt in a large bowl and mix well until combined. Make sure you break up any clumps.
2. Divide the mixture into 3 mixing bowls. Add blue mica to the 1st bowl, gold mica to the 2nd bowl, and red mica to the 3rd bowl.
3. Slowly drizzle the melted coconut and fragrance oils, and half of the melted shea butter onto each of the powders and mix quickly. Make sure to distribute them throughout the ingredients.
4. Check your mixtures by squeezing them with your hand. If the mixture is moldable, then you are ready to mold. You want them to be wet enough to clump together, but not too wet. If the mixtures crumble or they don't hold together, slowly add more shea butter until moldable.
5. Sprinkle sparkle white mica into your molds.
6. Press the baking soda mixtures into molds. Start with the gold mixture then layer the blue mixture on top and finish off with the red mixture. Sprinkle some sparkle white mica on top of the mixture and press in.
7. Allow the bath bombs to dry for 4 – 6 hours, or until they have hardened completely.
8. When dry, unmold your bath bombs and store in an airtight container or bag.

## How To Use:

Drop one bath bomb in a warm bath. It releases a super-sweet scent of sugared strawberry, sweet peach, ripe raspberry and cotton candy – you'll enjoy a fragrant, relaxing and truly *magical* soak!

It also gives the water a soft blue, gold and pink hue. Plus some sparkle!
